When visiting the Cathedral you have 2 options:

Alternatively, if you arrange your visit with the Learning Team, entry for children aged 4+ is £4 per child. Those under 4 are free of charge.

Accompanying adults may be free of charge depending on the age/s of the children – speak to the Learning Team for details. Additional adults are £5 inc.VAT.

Cathedral tours led by the Learning Team are available lasting 45-60 minutes (depending on the age of the child/ren).

Art workshops led by the Learning Team are available lasting 45-60 minutes (depending on the age of the child/ren). Popular art workshops include clay gargoyle making workshops and creating stained glass windows.
